<u>Leviticus 7:7</u> As the sin offering is, so is the trespass offering: there is one law for them: the priest that maketh atonement therewith shall have it.

Leviticus 8:34 As he hath done this day, so the LORD hath commanded to do, to make an atonement for you.

<u>Leviticus 9:7</u> And Moses said unto Aaron, Go unto the altar, and offer thy sin offering, and thy burnt offering, and make an atonement for thyself, and for the people: and offer the offering of the people, and make an atonement for them; as the LORD commanded.

<u>Leviticus 10:17</u> Wherefore have ye not eaten the sin offering in the holy place, seeing it is most holy, and God hath given it you to bear the iniquity of the congregation, to make atonement for them before the LORD?

<u>Leviticus 12:7</u> Who shall offer it before the LORD, and make an atonement for her; and she shall be cleansed from the issue of her blood. This is the law for her that hath born a male or a female.

<u>Leviticus 12:8</u> And if she be not able to bring a lamb, then she shall bring two turtles, or two young pigeons; the one for the burnt offering, and the other for a sin offering: and the priest shall make an atonement for her, and she shall be clean.

<u>Leviticus 14:18</u> And the remnant of the oil that is in the priest's hand he shall pour upon the head of him that is to be cleansed: and the priest shall make an atonement for him before the LORD.

<u>Leviticus 14:19</u> And the priest shall offer the sin offering, and make an atonement for him that is to be cleansed from his uncleanness; and afterward he shall kill the burnt offering:

<u>Leviticus 14:20</u> And the priest shall offer the burnt offering and the meat offering upon the altar: and the priest shall make an atonement for him, and he shall be clean.

<u>Leviticus 14:21</u> And if he be poor, and cannot get so much; then he shall take one lamb for a trespass offering to be waved, to make an atonement for him, and one tenth deal of fine flour mingled with oil for a meat offering, and a log of oil;

<u>Leviticus 14:29</u> And the rest of the oil that is in the priest's hand he shall put upon the head of him that is to be cleansed, to make an atonement for him before the LORD.

<u>Leviticus 14:31</u> Even such as he is able to get, the one for a sin offering, and the other for a burnt offering, with the meat offering: and the priest shall make an atonement for him that is to be cleansed before the LORD.

<u>Leviticus 14:53</u> But he shall let go the living bird out of the city into the open fields, and make an atonement for the house: and it shall be clean.

<u>Leviticus 15:15</u> And the priest shall offer them, the one for a sin offering, and the other for a burnt offering; and the priest shall make an atonement for him before the LORD for his issue.

<u>Leviticus 15:30</u> And the priest shall offer the one for a sin offering, and the other for a burnt offering; and the priest shall make an atonement for her before the LORD for the issue of her uncleanness.

<u>Leviticus 16:6</u> And Aaron shall offer his bullock of the sin offering, which is for himself, and make an atonement for himself, and for his house.

<u>Leviticus 16:10</u> But the goat, on which the lot fell to be the scapegoat, shall be presented alive before the LORD, to make an atonement with him, and to let him go for a scapegoat into the wilderness.

<u>Leviticus 16:11</u> And Aaron shall bring the bullock of the sin offering, which is for himself, and shall make an atonement for himself, and for his house, and shall kill the bullock of the sin offering which is for himself:

<u>Leviticus 16:16</u> And he shall make an atonement for the holy place, because of the uncleanness of the children of Israel, and because of their transgressions in all their sins: and so shall he do for the tabernacle of the congregation, that remaineth among them in the midst of their uncleanness.

<u>Leviticus 16:17</u> And there shall be no man in the tabernacle of the congregation when he goeth in to make an atonement in the holy place, until he come out, and have made an atonement for himself, and for his household, and for all the congregation of Israel.

<u>Leviticus 16:18</u> And he shall go out unto the altar that is before the LORD, and make an atonement for it; and shall take of the blood of the blood of the blood of the goat, and put it upon the horns of the altar round about.

<u>Leviticus 16:24</u> And he shall wash his flesh with water in the holy place, and put on his garments, and come forth, and offer his burnt offering, and the burnt offering of the people, and make an atonement for himself, and for the people.

<u>Leviticus 16:27</u> And the bullock for the sin offering, and the goat for the sin offering, whose blood was brought in to make atonement in the holy place, shall one carry forth without the camp; and they shall burn in the fire their skins, and their flesh, and their dung.

<u>Leviticus 16:30</u> For on that day shall the priest make an atonement for you, to cleanse you, that ye may be clean from all your sins before the LORD.

<u>Leviticus 16:32</u> And the priest, whom he shall anoint, and whom he shall consecrate to minister in the priest's office in his father's stead, shall make the atonement, and shall put on the linen clothes, even the holy garments:

<u>Leviticus 16:33</u> And he shall make an atonement for the holy sanctuary, and he shall make an atonement for the tabernacle of the congregation, and for the altar, and he shall make an atonement for the priests, and for all the people of the congregation.

<u>Leviticus 16:34</u> And this shall be an everlasting statute unto you, to make an atonement for the children of Israel for all their sins once a year. And he did as the LORD commanded Moses.

<u>Leviticus 17:11</u> For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.

<u>Leviticus 19:22</u> And the priest shall make an atonement for him with the ram of the trespass offering before the LORD for his sin which he hath done: and the sin which he hath done shall be forgiven him.

<u>Leviticus 23:27</u> Also on the tenth day of this seventh month there shall be a day of atonement: it shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD.

<u>Leviticus 23:28</u> And ye shall do no work in that same day: for it is a day of atonement, to make an atonement for you before the LORD your God.

<u>Leviticus 25:9</u> Then shalt thou cause the trumpet of the jubile to sound on the tenth day of the seventh month, in the day of atonement shall ye make the trumpet sound throughout all your land.

<u>Numbers 5:8</u> But if the man have no kinsman to recompense the trespass unto, let the trespass be recompensed unto the LORD, even to the priest; beside the ram of the atonement, whereby an atonement shall be made for him.

<u>Numbers 6:11</u> And the priest shall offer the one for a sin offering, and the other for a burnt offering, and make an atonement for him, for that he sinned by the dead, and shall hallow his head that same day.

<u>Numbers 8:12</u> And the Levites shall lay their hands upon the heads of the bullocks: and thou shalt offer the one for a sin offering, and the other for a burnt offering, unto the LORD, to make an atonement for the Levites.

<u>Numbers 8:19</u> And I have given the Levites as a gift to Aaron and to his sons from among the children of Israel, to do the service of the children of Israel in the tabernacle of the congregation, and to make an atonement for the children of Israel: that there be no plague among the children of Israel, when the children of Israel come nigh unto the sanctuary.

<u>Numbers 8:21</u> And the Levites were purified, and they washed their clothes; and Aaron offered them as an offering before the LORD; and Aaron made an atonement for them to cleanse them.

<u>Numbers 15:25</u> And the priest shall make an atonement for all the congregation of the children of Israel, and it shall be forgiven them; for it is ignorance: and they shall bring their offering, a sacrifice made by fire unto the LORD, and their sin offering before the LORD, for their ignorance:

<u>Numbers 15:28</u> And the priest shall make an atonement for the soul that sinneth ignorantly, when he sinneth by ignorance before the LORD, to make an atonement for him; and it shall be forgiven him.

<u>Numbers 16:46</u> And Moses said unto Aaron, Take a censer, and put fire therein from off the altar, and put on incense, and go quickly unto the congregation, and make an atonement for them: for there is wrath gone out from the LORD; the plague is begun.

<u>Numbers 16:47</u> And Aaron took as Moses commanded, and ran into the midst of the congregation; and, behold, the plague was begun among the people: and he put on incense, and made an atonement for the people.

<u>Numbers 25:13</u> And he shall have it, and his seed after him, even the covenant of an everlasting priesthood; because he was zealous for his God, and made an atonement for the children of Israel.

Numbers 28:22 And one goat for a sin offering, to make an atonement for you.

Numbers 28:30 And one kid of the goats, to make an atonement for you.

Numbers 29:5 And one kid of the goats for a sin offering, to make an atonement for you:

<u>Numbers 29:11</u> One kid of the goats for a sin offering; beside the sin offering of atonement, and the continual burnt offering, and the meat offering of it, and their drink offerings.

<u>Numbers 31:50</u> We have therefore brought an oblation for the LORD, what every man hath gotten, of jewels of gold, chains, and bracelets, rings, earrings, and tablets, to make an atonement for our souls before the LORD.

<u>2Samuel 21:3</u> Wherefore David said unto the Gibeonites, What shall I do for you? and wherewith shall I make the atonement, that ye may bless the inheritance of the LORD?

<u>1Chronicles 6:49</u> But Aaron and his sons offered upon the altar of the burnt offering, and on the altar of incense, and were appointed for all the work of the place most holy, and to make an atonement for Israel, according to all that Moses the servant of God had commanded.

Nehemiah 10:33 For the shewbread, and for the continual meat offering, and for the continual burnt offering, of the sabbaths, of the new moons, for the set feasts, and for the holy things, and for the sin offerings to make an atonement for Israel, and for all the work of the house of our God.

Romans 5:11 And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord yashayaChrist, by whom we have now received the atonement.

Sirach 3:3 Whoso honoureth his father maketh an atonement for his sins:

**Sirach 3:30** Water will quench a flaming fire; and alms maketh an atonement for sins.

**2Maccabees 3:33** Now as the high priest was making an atonement, the same young men in the same clothing appeared and stood beside Heliodorus, saying, Give Onias the high priest great thanks, insomuch as for his sake the Lord hath granted thee life:

**Psalms 69:13 (KJV)** But as for me, my prayer *is* unto thee, O LORD, *in* an acceptable time: O God, in the multitude of thy mercy hear me, in the truth of thy salvation.

**Psalms 69:13 (KJV)** But as for me, my prayer *is* unto thee, O LORD, *in* an acceptable time: O AHAYAH, in the multitude of thy mercy hear me, in the truth of thy salvation.

**2 Esdras 7:34 (KJVA)** But judgment only shall remain, truth shall stand, and faith shall wax strong: **Psalms 63:3 (KJVA)** Because thy lovingkindness *is* better than life, my lips shall praise thee.
