

Exodus 3:15 And **God** said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, The **LORD** God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: **this is my name for ever**, and **this is my memorial unto all generations**.

Modern Hebrew: I Am that I Am אֲהַיֶּה אֲשֶׁר אֲהַיֶּה, *ehyeh ašer ehyeh* [eh'je a'fer eh'je]) is the common English translation (JPS among others) of the response that **God** used in the Hebrew Bible when Moses asked for his **name** (Exodus 3:14). It is one of the most famous verses in the Torah. **Hayah** means "existed" in Hebrew; **ehyeh** is the first person singular imperfect form and is usually translated in English Bibles as "**I am**" or "I will be" (or "I shall be"), for example, at Exodus 3:14. **Ehyeh asher ehyeh** literally translates as "I Am Who

I Am." The ancient Hebrew of Exodus 3:14 lacks a future tense such as modern English has, yet a few translations render this name as "I Will Be What I Will Be,"



Exodus 3:14 God said to Moses, "AHAYAH ashar ASHAR and He said, "So shall you say to the children of Israel, 'AHAYAH has sent me to you.'"


